

Regulations for audience entry to concerts during the COVID-19 pandemic

1. Before entering the area of Frederic Chopin's Manor House (Dworek Chopina), each concert participant is obliged to submit in the designated places (ticket offices) a written statement that to the best of her/ his knowledge s/he is not an infected person and is not under quarantine or under epidemiological surveillance.
2. The event participant's statement is submitted in connection with the current epidemiological situation.
3. Entering and staying within the area of the premises of the Dworek Chopina is possible with keeping a distance of at least 1.5 meters between people.
4. The audience shall occupy purchased seats. It is forbidden to take another seat in the Concert Hall.
5. The Foundation of the International Chopin Piano Festivals provides for the audience disinfectant fluids that are located in the entrance and exit areas as well as access to running hot water and soap in the restrooms.
6. Persons infected by the COVID-19 or being under quarantine are not allowed to be in the "Dworek Chopina" building.
7. Each concert participant is obliged to wear a protective mask provided by the participant herself/ himself during the whole time spent within the area of the premises of the Dworek Chopina (including during the concert).
8. People waiting to enter the Dworek Chopina, queuing at ticket offices or waiting to enter toilets should keep an appropriate distance and avoid large gatherings.
9. Exit of the audience from a concert should be conducted in accordance with directions of the festival staff, taking into account an appropriate time margin for safe movement in order to limit excessive gatherings of the audience in common communication spaces and passageways.
10. Ticket offices will be open from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., with a break from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.
11. Before entering the concerts at Chopin's Manor, interested persons will be asked to present a current negative PCR test or COVID-19 antigen test (in Polish or English) or a vaccination certificate, performed no later than 48 hours ago. People with a festival pass are kindly asked to present their test results before the first concert.
12. Personal data of ticket purchasers will be processed in accordance with the applicable regulations for the processing of personal data due to the COVID-19 outbreak (statement).
13. Non-cash form of payments is preferred at the ticket offices.

14. On a day when there are 2 concerts in the Concert Hall, the time between the end of the first concert and the beginning of the second concert must include a minimum of 1 hour break for the preparation of the Hall.
15. Buying a ticket for a concert taking place in the Dworek Chopina is tantamount to accepting these Regulations for audience entry to concerts during the COVID-19 pandemic by the participant.
